The Schools allocation for Pupil Premium for 2012/2013 was £72,768

This allocation was spent on the following:

- Increased number of subsidised school trips to support literacy skills.
- Appointment of an Oracy teacher to target poor speakers
- Employment of Parental Support Worker(s).
- Increased number of before and after school clubs.
- Appointment of behavioural support worker
- Enhanced support staff provision across school.

The schools allocation for Pupil Premium for 2013/2014 is £104,000

This is intended to be spent to raise pupil's attainment and raise attainment through the following:

- Maintain the number of enhanced support staff provision across school.
- Enhanced training for all staff focusing on teaching and learning.
- Attendance and behaviour awards.
- Maintain number of subsidised school trips to support literacy skills.
- Appointment of full time attendance officer to address attendance issues of some children.
- Enhance school garden to create outdoor space for learning experiences.
- Maintain number of before and after school clubs.
